The master plan for this 1902 Carnegie Library maintains the character of the building while meeting the contemporary needs of the community. Phased construction included the entire restoration of the exterior and the construction of an addition to provide a handicap-accessible entry and space for reference material and staff.

The addition incorporates many of the architectural details of the existing historic structure while reorienting the entrance in preparation for a future addition. Later phases of renovations included the restoration of the interior and exterior of the original Carnegie Library building.
