

## Emma Willard School

Troy, New York



The Emma Willard School is the oldest secondary school for girls. The historic campus, built in the early 1900s, features historic Gothic architecture. We have completed numerous projects that have included evaluation, planning, and schematic design.

### Campus Signage and Wayfinding Program

architecture+ designed a signage system that was easily identifiable yet sensitive to the historic campus. Our design solution complements the campus and represents the school's identity. We worked closely with the school to determine the optimum signage locations.

### Wellington/Lay Hall

We evaluated alternative uses for a three-story mansion and provided schematic design services for its conversion to a conference center and student residence. Ultimately, we designed the renovation of the second floor into the Head of School residence.

### Performing Arts Center Study

We completed a planning and pre-design study evaluating the reuse of existing campus buildings coupled with new construction.

### Lyon Remington Hall

We evaluated alternative uses for the school's library and prepared schematic design for a reception hall/study for prospective students and a community meeting place.

### Kiggins Hall Seating

We selected new temporary auditorium seating and designed and provided specifications for permanent seating that duplicates the original historic seating.

### Cluett House

We designed the renovation of half of the building for faculty and student housing.

### Bridges

We designed the renovations for the experimental student housing at this freestanding building on campus.

### Sage/Hyphen/Kellas

We designed bedroom reconfigurations for the residence halls and are currently designing the complete renovation of twelve of the bathrooms in Sage and Hyphen.
