This project involved the adaptive reuse and conversion of an historic residence for use as the Town of Colonie's Cultural Center. It included extensive masonry rebuilding and preserving features such as the original stoves and bread ovens. The building was fitted with climate and temperature control systems to protect its historic artifacts and paintings. The grounds, out buildings and barn were preserved and provide an interesting setting for a variety of outdoor community activities.
