

Troy Public Safety Building

Troy, New York



The renovated facility houses the police department and court system. The original three-story 48,000 square foot brick building was constructed in 1925 as a police and fire station.

We developed a Master Plan and designed the renovations to address the programmatic needs of both the police department and court system. The plan was phased to allow continuous operation of essential services and to implement as funding became available.

The building includes 16,000 square feet for the Troy City Court facilities, which operate independently from police operations, and includes two courtrooms, judges' offices, administrative offices, secure holding facilities, and other ancillary facilities in accordance with the New York State Office of Court Administration Standards.

The facility also includes a 32,000 square foot police department with a new juvenile department, detention and booking areas, vehicle sally port, information services bureau, meeting rooms, evidence storage facilities, and locker rooms.
